Present continuous (affirmative, negative)

Affirmative	
full forms	short forms
I am reading	I 'm reading
you are reading	you 're reading
he is reading	he 's reading
she is reading	she 's reading
it is reading	it 's reading
we are reading	we 're reading
you are reading	you 're reading
they are reading	they 're reading

Negative	
full forms	short forms
I am not reading	I 'm not reading
you are not reading	you aren't reading
he is not reading	he isn't reading
she is not reading	she isn't reading
it is not reading	it isn't reading
we are not reading	we aren't reading
you are not reading	you aren't reading
they are not reading	they aren't reading

Kate, Dan, and Ros are looking for Ben.
He's buying a football shirt.

Dan isn't doing his homework.
They aren't visiting their uncle.

Present continuous (spelling)

Ben is reading. Kate is dancing. Ros is shopping.

- 1 *En casi todos los verbos se añade **ing**.*
read → **reading**
- 2 *En los verbos que terminan en **e** se quita la **e** y se añade **ing**.*
dance → **dancing**
- 3 *En algunos verbos que terminan en consonante precedida de vocal, se dobla la consonante y se añade **ing**.*
shop → **shopping**
