Course Title: Reading Topic: Food

Level: Intermediate

Materials: reading text A brief history of pizza from Headway Intermediate

Objectives: - to give students an opportunity to practise reading for specific details,

names of seafood and fish,

- to give students an opportunity to enlarge vocabulary on types of food,

and review of *like* and verb patterns
