



# THE REPUBLIC OF KARAKALPAKSTAN







## ANDIJAN REGION





#### JIZZAK REGION





# N&VOI REGION



### NAMANGAN REGION








The Namangan region is included into the three regions of the Fergana valley. The region is not big 7,4 thousand km. The Namangan region was founded on March 6,1941.

## SURKHANDARYA REGION





The population is equal to 1705,7 thousand people. The erea of the region is 20,1 thousand km 2. Termez is the administrative city of the region.






# SYRDARYA REGION





The region is located on the left bank of the Syrdarya river as it flows out from the Fergana valley.

The Tashkent region is the capital region of Uzbekistan.It was founded on January 15,1938.There are 15 rural discricts in the region and 17 towns.


# KASHKADARYA REGION
