

THE EASY WAYS OF LEARNING ENGLISH

We should create the ideal time ourselves, otherwise we will end up waiting for all our life [1].

So, how to learn new words.

Reading more books in English has lots of benefits.

Firstly, reading books helps us learn the words in the context. It means that words come within different stories and situations.

Secondly, reading books helps us revise the words we already learned a long time ago. This helps us boost our confidence and increase our motivation.

Thirdly, it increases one's imagination because when we read, we will have to imagine everything that the author describes. Imagination is very helpful when we want to write an essay.

- 1) increases our imagination;

- 3) Use new words in any type of communication possible.

When trying to explain ideas in English, we should be flexible with vocabulary. Many cadets try to find the exact word and get stuck in the middle of their speech. This happens because when learning English they try to translate from their mother language into English [2].

Their vocabulary in mother language is quite higher than the vocabulary in English. Because they have been learning the words of their mother language since they were born. But what about English? I don't think it is the same situation with English. So what can we do about it?

If we can't find the exact words when we speak English to our friends, teacher or others, we shouldn't worry because we don't have to use the exact words. Instead, we should try to find a synonym, equivalent or similar words to that exact word we wish to use.

If we just started speaking English, I am sure we will make mistakes, anyway. *They say originality is in simplicity.* So be simple. Use simple, easy-to-construct and easy-to-understand sentences so that you feel easy to speak and your companion feels easy to understand.

When speaking English with friends, for a start, it is useful trying to discuss easy topics like food, weather, homework, studies, friends, teachers, books and etc. Because difficult topics require quite advanced level of vocabulary, complex sentence structures. We can discuss them later on when we become quite confident in speaking English.

Also, many students and cadets think that if they speak English fast, then it means they know English very well. No, it is not so.

Focus on the following aspect of speaking skills:

- Organization of your speech;
- Clarity of the speech;
- Appropriateness of words used;
- Intonation/tone;
- Pronunciation;
- Voice projection;

- Stress;
- Linking words;
- Grammar;

In conclusion I want to say that the fastest way of learning English is not stopping learning when you are out of your classroom. Do not just limit yourself with your English lessons at school or college or university. Do not limit yourself with homework given by your teacher. Learn English 24 hours 7 days and you will soon see real results. This is the shortest way [3].
