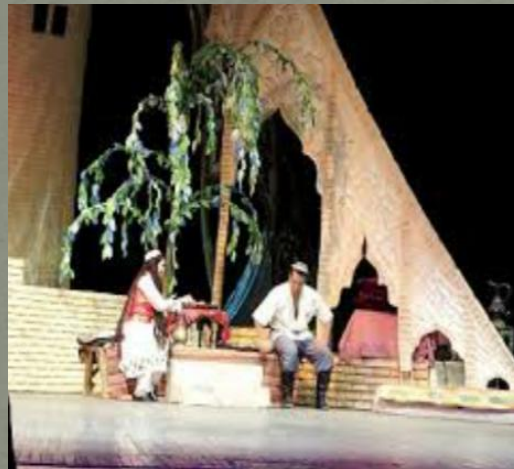
History of Theatre...



- *Uzbek National Academic Drama Theatre was founded on February 27, 1914.*
- *The theatre has begun to work in Tashkent since 1931.*
- *The same year it was named after Hamza, later in 1937 according to the government, it was named Academic.emic Drama Theatre.*
- *On September 21, 2001 according to the decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan the Uzbek State Theatre named after Khamza was renamed Uzbek National Academic Drama Theatre.*

- *The theatre accommodates 540 seats.*
- *The performances are held in the Uzbek language.*
- *The performances of different genres: comedy, tragedy, drama as well as classical works.*
